

- Mapping between service metadata and "Describe XXX service metadata" information
 - Help people produce service metadata
 - Improve the quality of the information contained in the "Describe XXX" service metadata" document






Guidelines on discovery service

Experts discussion


The link between data metadata and view or download service need to be improved so that it is transparent for the user in the catalogue viewer.

It is necessary to make this link as transparent as possible for the user.





Title:

Implementation Requirement 33

It is mapped with <wms:Title>. The harmonised title of a layer for an INSPIRE spatial data theme is defined by [INS DS] and shall be subject to multilingualism (translations shall appear in each mono-lingual capabilities localised documents)

Name:

The harmonised name of a layer for an INSPIRE spatial data theme as defined by [INS DS] Implementation Requirement 39


Name shall be mapped with the <wms:Name> element. The harmonised name of a layer shall comply with the Layer requirements of the [INS DS, Article 14]





Guidelines on view service

- Experts discussion
 - It is necessary to be able to extend the layer name and layer title in many cases :
- Several versions are available:
 - BSS EAU V0 ⇔ BSS EAU V1,
 - BD ORTHO 2011 ⇔ BD ORTHO 2012
- Several scales are available:
 - BD ALTI25 ⇔ BD ALTI50
- Data are generated in small areas: urban data produced by cities
 - PLU Lorient ⇔ PLU Rennes









Guidelines on view service

- Decided to relax the constraints on the title
- Add a suffix to the name :
 - OI.OrthoimageCoverage.2012
 - OI.OrthoimageCoverage.2011
- A new MIG work item (20) has been created MIG.
 - Discussion to be continued on RedMine
